Description of Levels:

1 = At or approaching grade level or short term intervention needed for students above grade – If the student is in their current grade level range little to

no remediation is recommended; if the student is currently in a higher grade then "short term" intervention is needed (targeted instruction in the skill

deficit area out of and in context of contextual reading using multi-sensory strategies daily 10 – 20 minutes daily for one to four weeks.

2= Intermediate Intervention – The student will require targeted ongoing instruction (individually or in a group of 6 or less) in the skill deficit area out of and in context of contextual reading using multi-sensory strategies daily 20-30 minutes four to 12 weeks.

3= Intensive Intervention - The student will require intensive (individually or in a group of three or less) targeted, ongoing instruction in the skill deficit area out of and in context of contextual reading using multi-sensory strategies daily 45-60 minutes daily for three to six months or more depending on rate of improvement over time.
